- A true prophet edifies the church with counsel and advice in religious matters. I Corinthians 14: 3,4
- 8. A true prophet will be in absolute harmony with the words of preceding prophets.
 1 Corinthians 14:21; Isaiah 8:20
- 9. A true prophet recognizes the incarnation and divinity of Jesus Christ. 1 John 1-4
- 10. A true prophet, when in vision, will not breathe. Daniel 10:15, 17
- 11. A true prophet can be recognized by the results of his or her works. Matthew 7:16-20
- 12. A true prophet acts in accordance with the will and the approval of God expressed in the Bible in general and the Ten Commandments in particular. Deuteronomy 18:18,19



"But I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself." John 12:32

Twelve Tests of a True Prophet

- A true prophet does not lie. His non-conditional prediction will always be 100% right and accurate. Deuteronomy 18:21,22
- 2. A true prophet does not prophesy for fees, charges or payments. 2 Kings 5:15, 16
- 3. A true prophet does not give even his own private interpretation of his or another prophet's prophecy. It is always the Lord's interpretation based on what he was revealed. 2 Peter 1:20
- 4. A true prophet does not prophesy in his own name. It is always in the name of the Lord. 2 Peter 1:21
- 5. A true prophet points out the sins, transgressions and iniquities of the people against God. Isaiah 58:1
- 6. A true prophet warns the people of God's coming judgments. Isaiah 24:19-21
